CODE OF CONDUCT FOR NON-TEACHING STAFF

- 1. Non-teaching staff of the college should follow the rules and regulations laid by the competent higher authority.
- 2. Non-Teaching staff should maintain highest possible standard of professional behaviour.
- 3. Non-Teaching staff should be punctual and disciplined in their work.
- 4. Non-Teaching staff shall maintain appropriate level of confidentiality with respect to students staff records and other sensitive matters.
- 5. Non-Teaching staff should co-operate with the superiors, teachers, colleague and students.
- 6. Non-Teaching staff should maintain image of the institute through standard of dress and general courtesy.
- 7. They should respect the rights and opinions of others.
- 8. Every non-teaching staff should follow all norms and job assignment given to them by management with full dedication.
- 9. They should refrain from any form of harassment or unlawful discrimination based on race, caste, creed, sex or community.
- 10. Every non-teaching staff should respect and maintain the hierarchy in the administration and be supportive of the institution's norm.
- 11. In case of leave of absence, prior information need to be given and leave of absence applied for in time.
