

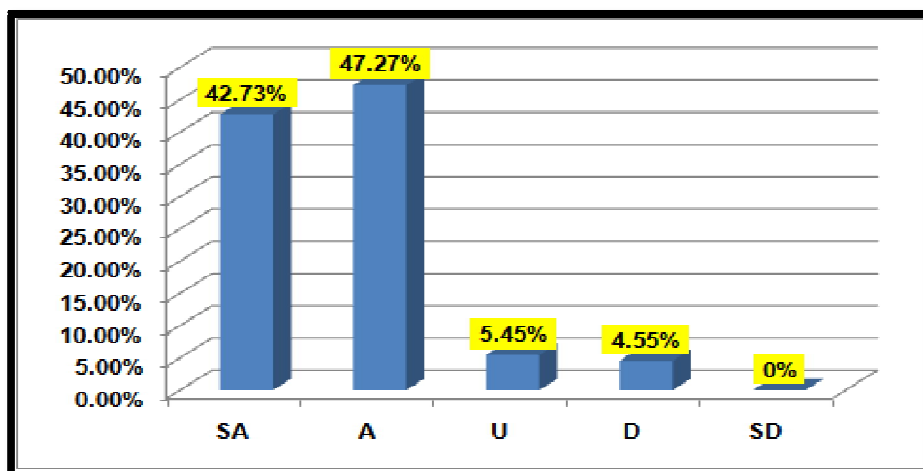

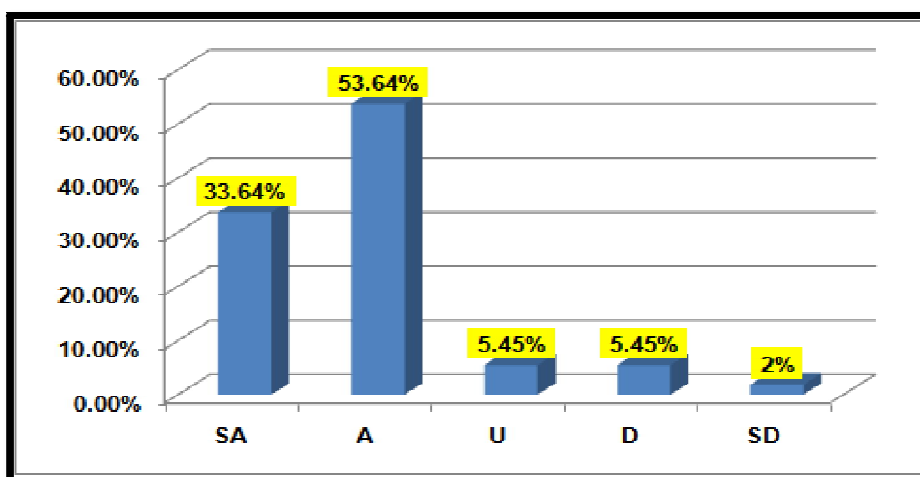
The responses of the students regarding teaching and assessment are presented in percentage format.

1. Lesson is prepared appropriately before entering/teaching any class.



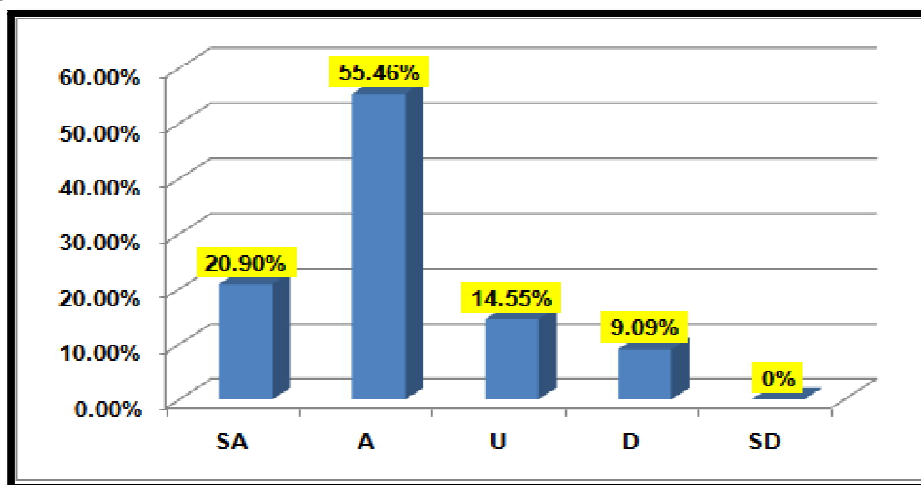
- 90% of total sample agreed the statement

2. Teaching is done in such a way to make students construct new knowledge.



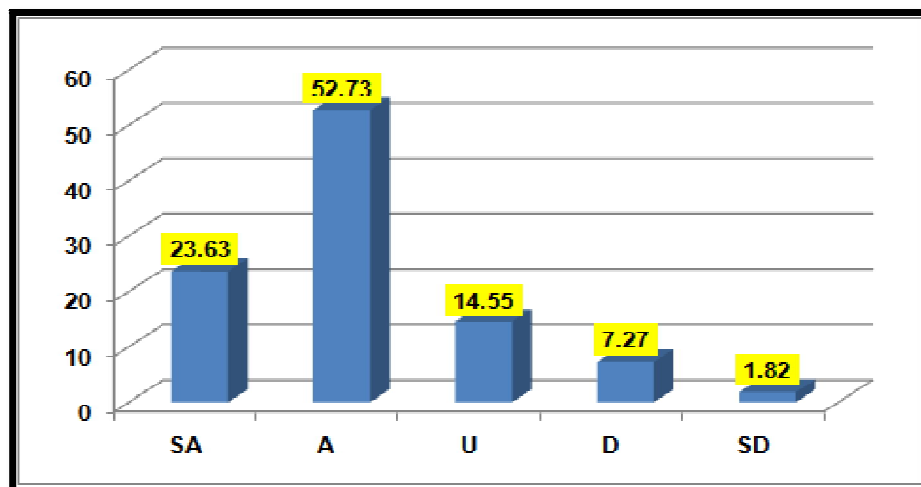
- 87.28% favoured the statement

- 76.36% of total students agreed the statement

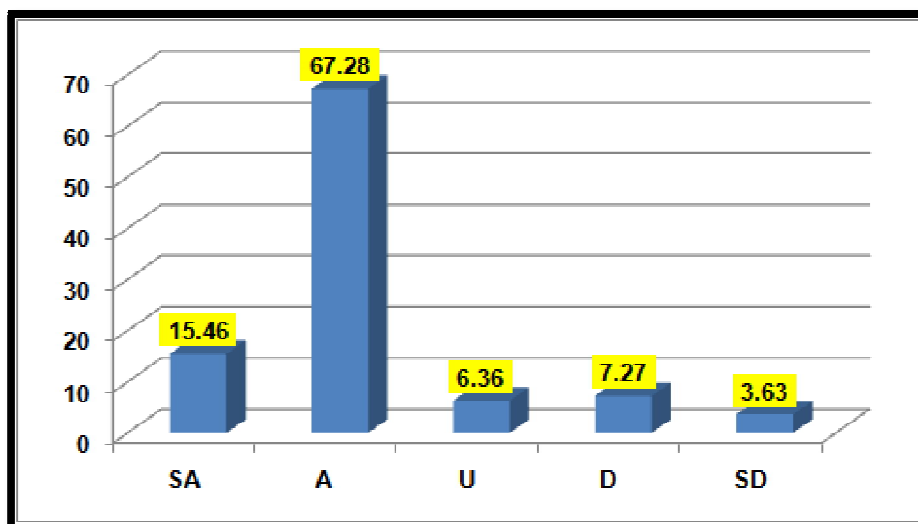
4. Orientation and workshop conducted for the teacher at the institution had been helpful



- 76.36 % of students agreed the above statement

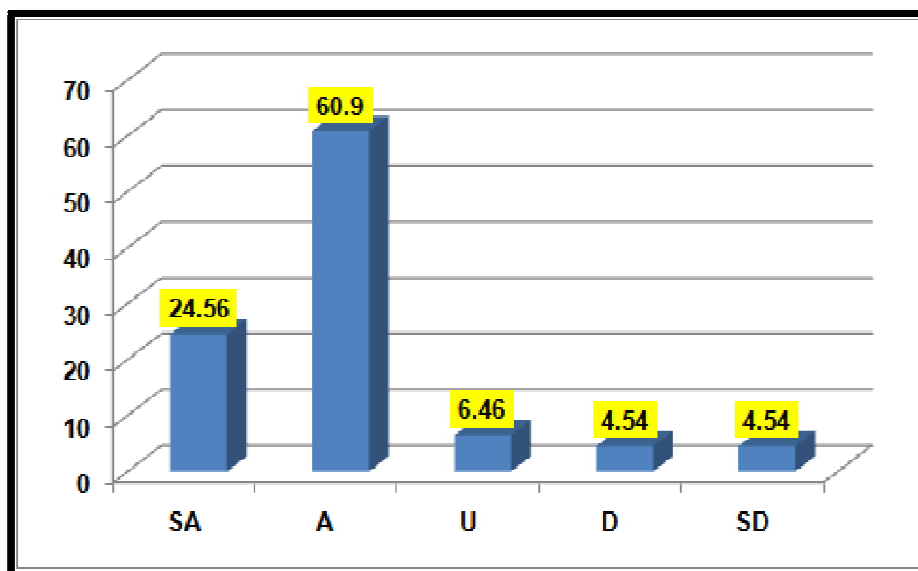

- 82.74% of total students agreed that class room is conducive

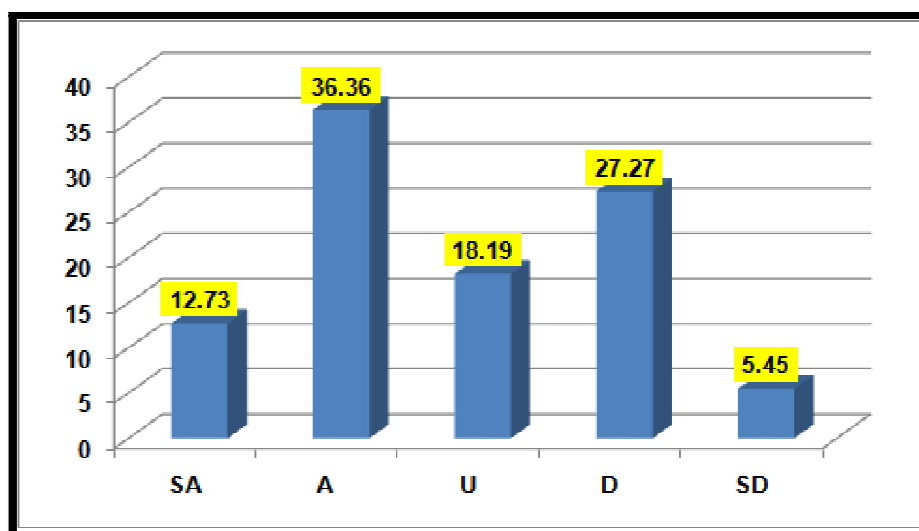
6. The teaching has helped the students to garner new knowledge



- 85.46 of students favoured the above statement

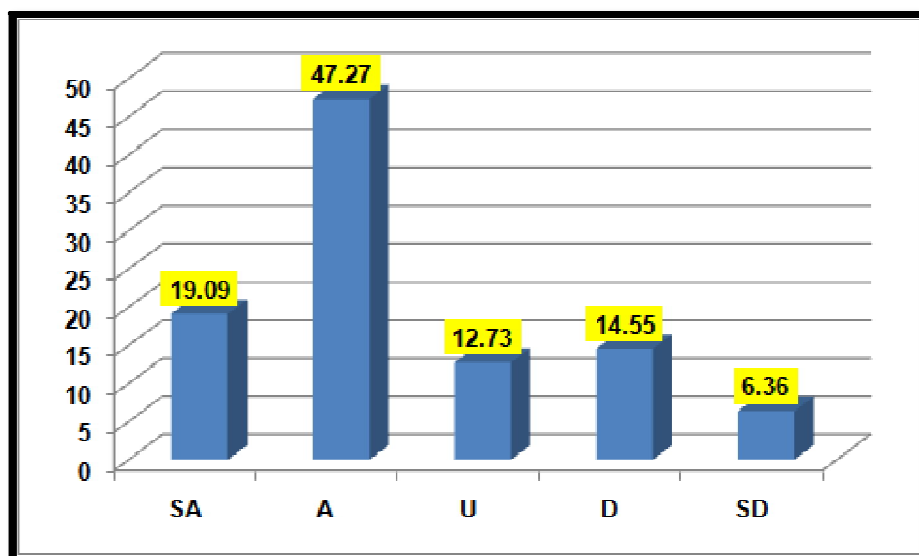

- 49.09% of total students agreed that syllabus is completed in time.

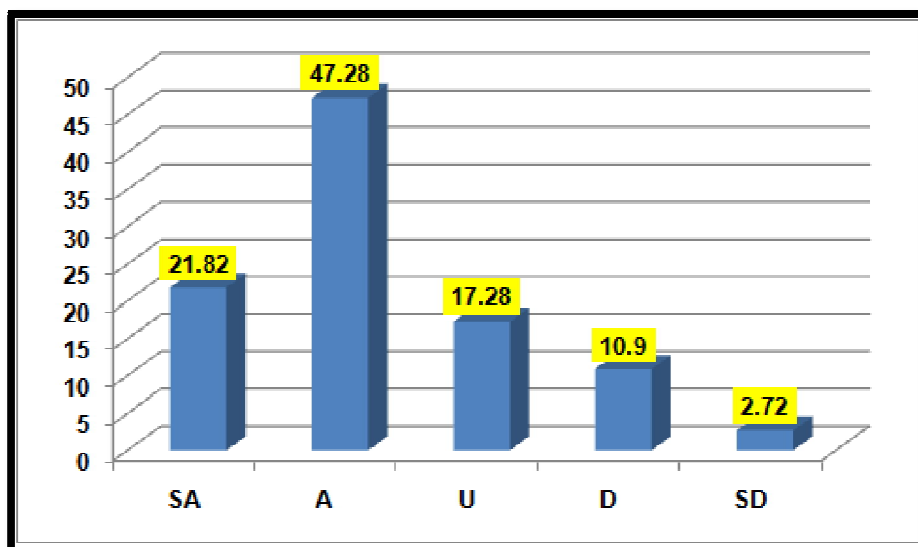
8. All concepts are explained clearly



- 66.36% of sample favoured the above statements

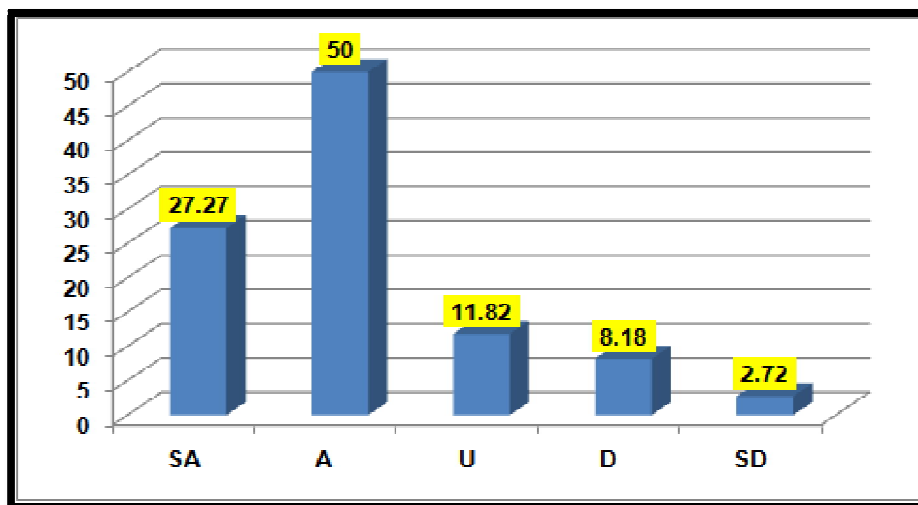

- 69.10% of sample agreed the maximum contribution of scholastic as well as co-scholastic area.

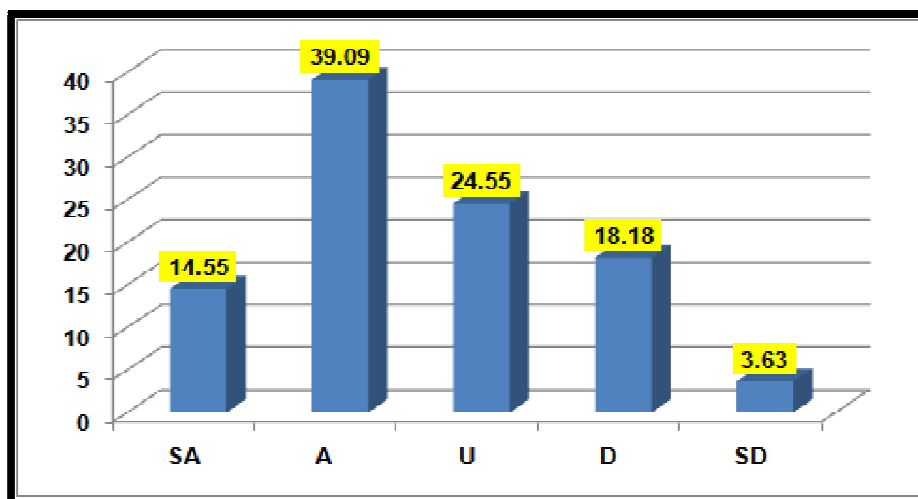
10. Proper teaching Aids/ICT had been utilised to make students understand better



- 77.27 of sample found the use of ICT/AIDS by the teachers

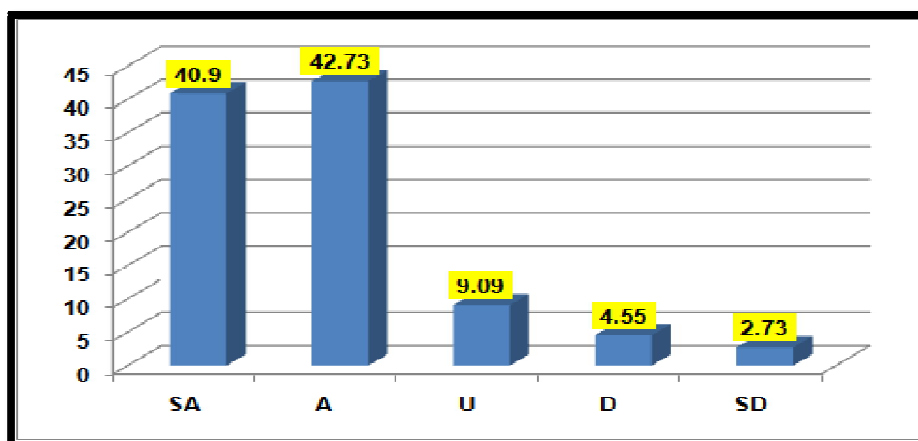

- 83.63 of students favoured the need the more knowledge to meet the requirement of the curriculum/students.

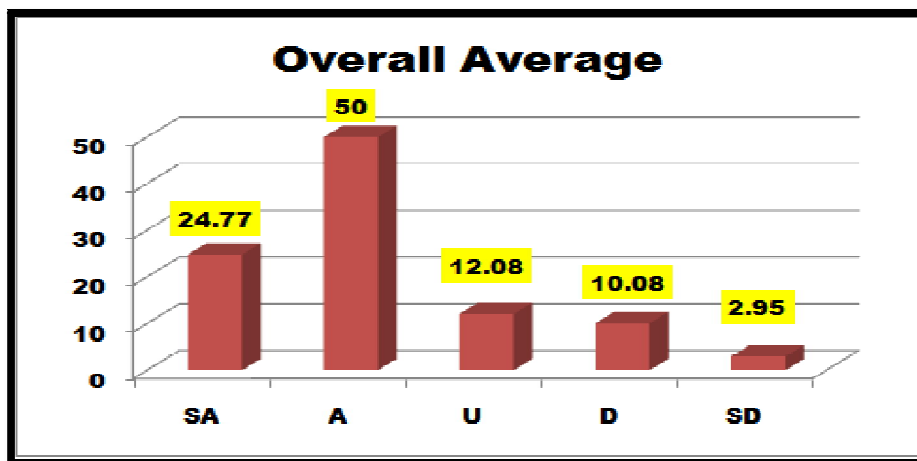


