### Q1. Lesson is prepared appropriately before entering/teaching any class.



Q2. Teaching is done in such a way to make students construct new knowledge.



Q3. Every lesson/portion taught is always linked to real life situations whenever required.



Q4. Orientation and workshop conducted for the teacher at the institution had been helpful.



Q5. There is conducive teaching learning atmosphere in the class



Q6. The teaching has helped the students to garner new knowledge.



## Q7. Syllabus is completed in time.



Q8. All concepts are explained clearly.



Q9. Teacher contributed maximum level to the college in both scholastic and co-scholastic area



Q10. Proper teaching aids/ICT had been utilized to make students understand better.



Q11. Instructional objectives set for every class is always fulfilled.



Q12. Teacher need to have more knowledge to meet the requirements of the curriculum/students.



### ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION

The feedback reveals that the students were satisfied with the overall performance of the teachers. One area of concern is in Q.7. Syllabus is completed in time. 33.3% of the respondents are undecided, 18.75% disagree and 12.5% strongly disagree. It reveals that the teacher need to put in effort to complete the syllabus in time. Another area of concern is to Q.12. Teachers need to have more knowledge to meet the requirements of the curriculum. The students 52% strongly agreed to it indicating that the faculty need to have more knowledge. The subjective feedbacks also indicated that the students required 24 hrs. wi-fi enabled campus and that the upgradation of the library was required.

#### ACTION TAKEN

After the analysis and interpretation of the questionnaire, the result was placed in the staff meeting of the college. It was decided to have more faculty development programmes and more welfare measures for all the staff of the college. It was also unanimously agreed that more books need to be purchased for the library and required funds to be sanctioned from the next academic year.
