


The responses of the student regarding teaching and assessment is presented in percentage format.

O15. Give suggestions to improve teaching learning experiences in your institution.

The students made various suggestions to improve teaching learning experience in the college. Some of the suggestions are given below:

- 1. Workshop & Orientation
- 2. Update Curriculum and syllabus to meet NEP 2020 requirements
- 3. Curriculum changes in alignment with NEP
- 4. Use of ICT based teaching-learning materials in the classrooms
- Support peer learning/Group discussion/Collaboration/learning/blended learning approaches.

Analysis Interpretation

The feedback of Teaching Assessment by the students shows that majority of the student teachers agreed that they are able to construct new knowledge with the teaching learning process in the classroom. 50% of the student teachers agreed that they are able to link the knowledge acquired from their course of study into their real life situations. Majority of the student teachers are satisfied with the orientation and workshop conducted at the institutions as it is helpful for academic as well as personality development. The faculty members contributed maximum level in development of both scholastic and co-scholastic area of development of student teachers. 56.5% of student teachers agrees that the teacher utilized latest and innovative teaching learning materials to make student teacher understand the teaching learning process in a better way.

Action Taken

With respect of the feedback of the student teachers, latest reading materials and books are to be uploaded in accordance to the needs of the curriculum. The teachers are also informed to complete the syllabus, use more of ICT based teaching-learning materials in the classroom and also to discuss the problems faced by the students. In order to align with NEP 2020, regular curriculum appraisal from time to time is being monitored. Emphasis is being made to support peer learning/Group Discussion/Collaborative learning/blended learning approaches. More orientation and workshop is planned to be taken up on a wider scale in the coming academic year.
