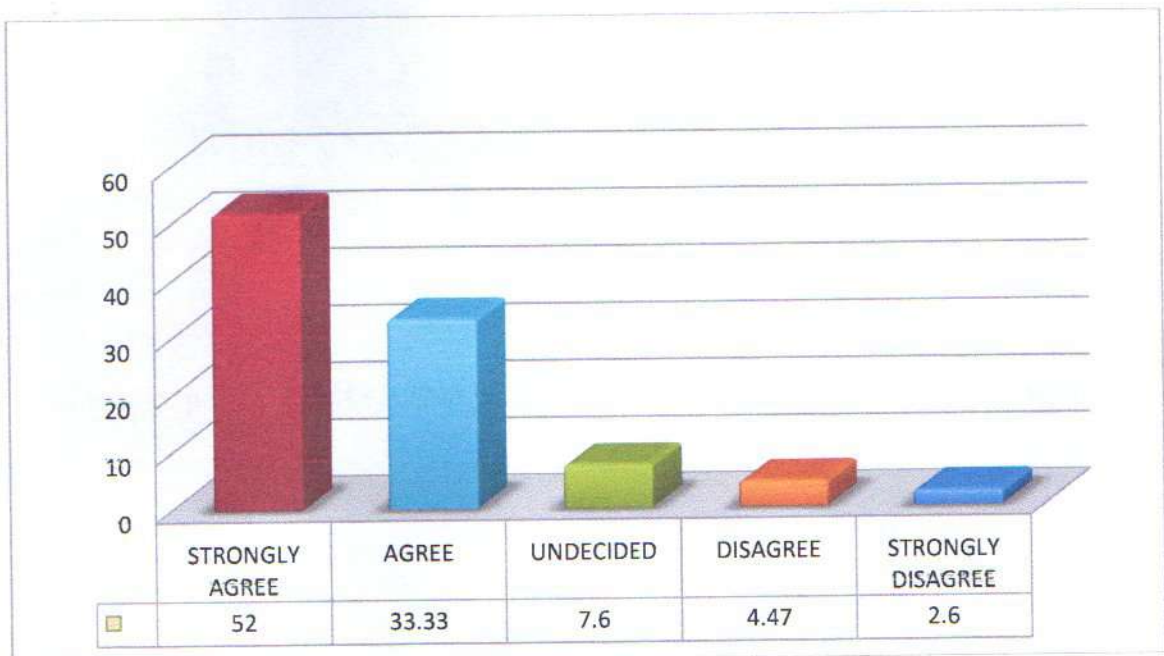
**TEACHING ASSESSMENT FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS, 2021-2022**

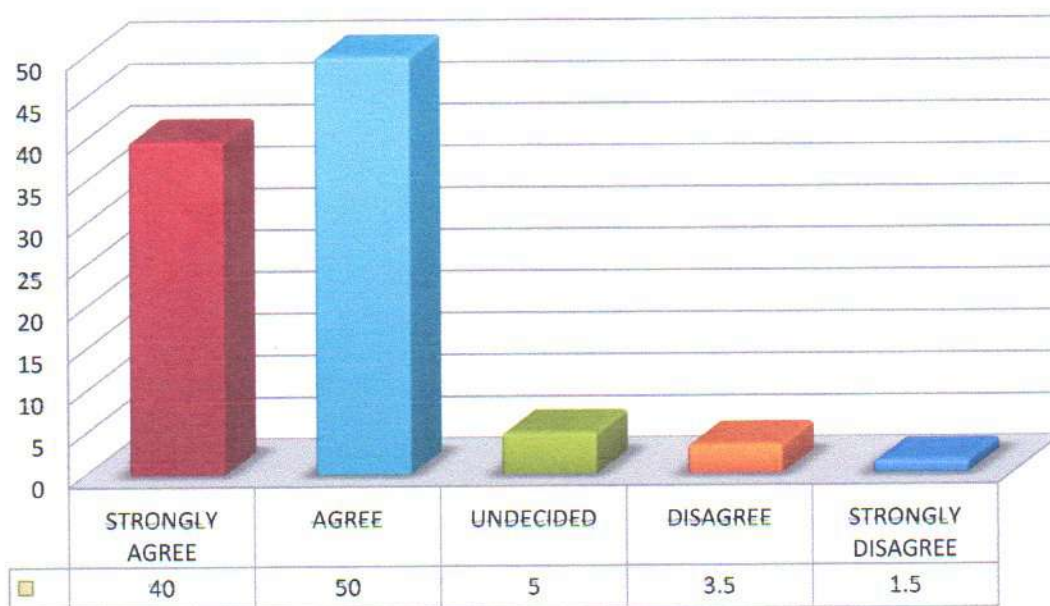
The responses of the student regarding teaching and assessment is presented in percentage format.

Q1. Lesson is prepared appropriately before entering/teaching any class.

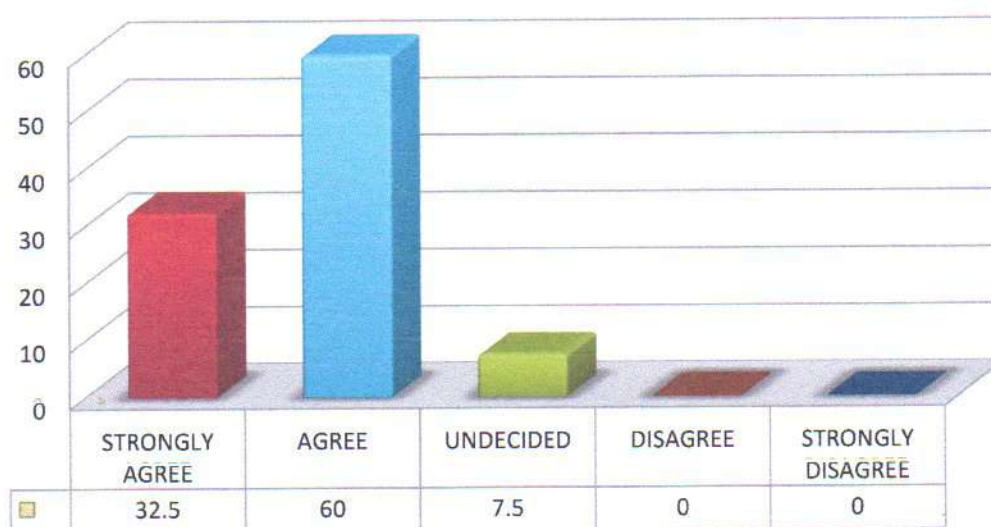


  
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Q2. Teaching is done in such a way to make students construct new knowledge.

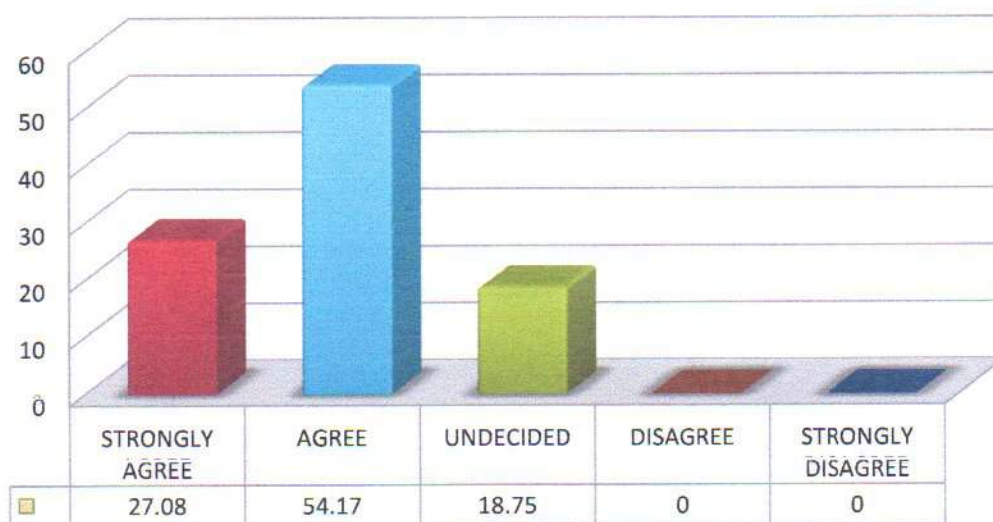


Q3. Every lesson/portion taught is always linked to real life situations whenever required.

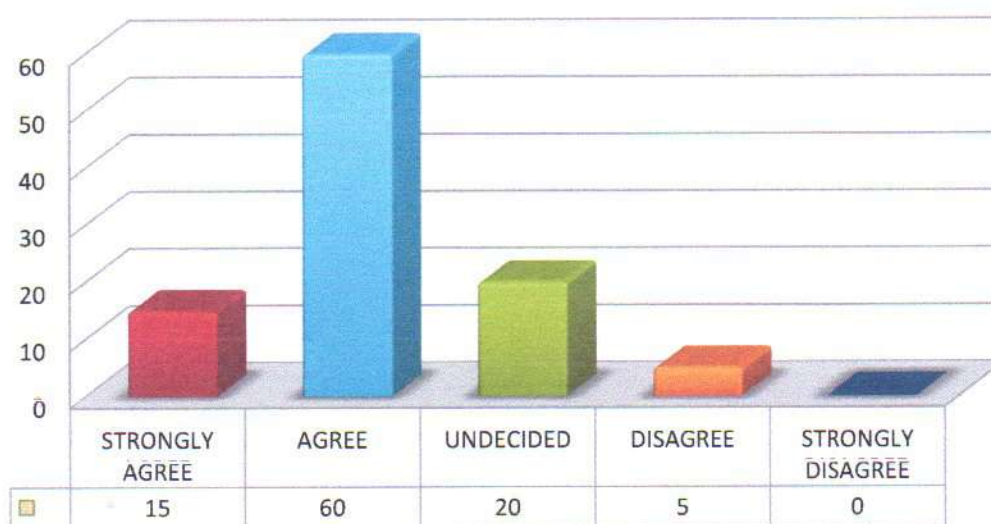


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Q4. Orientation and Workshop conducted for the teacher at the institution had been helpful.

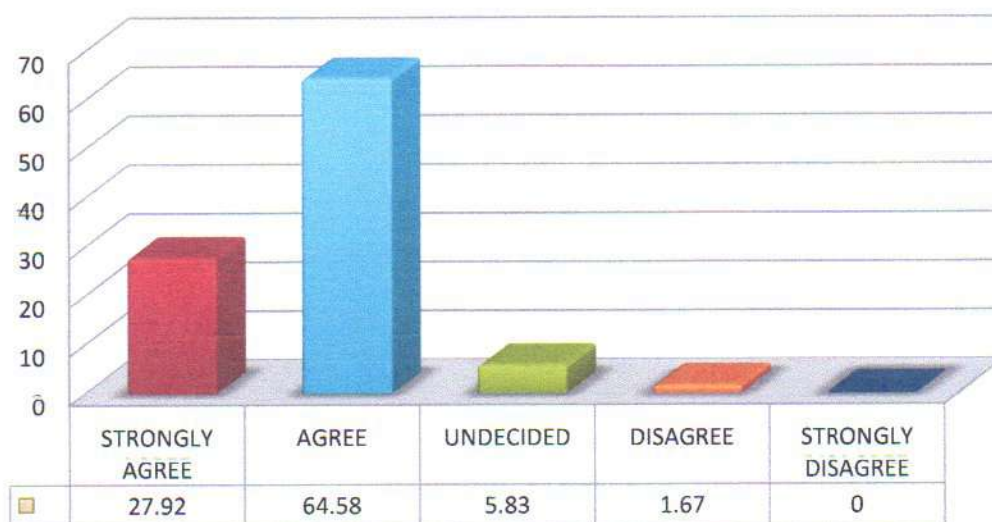


Q5. There is a conducive teaching learning atmosphere in the class.

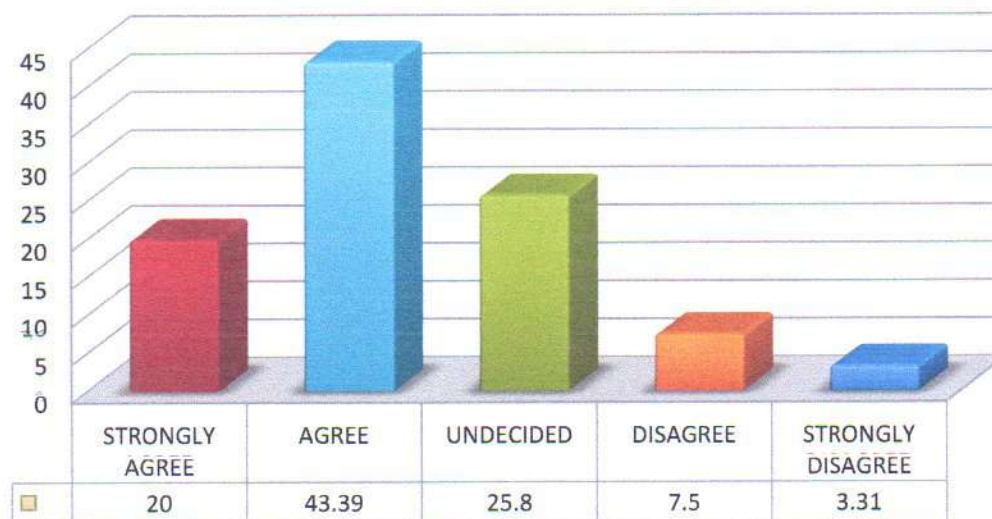



  
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Q6. The teaching has helped the students to garner new knowledge.



Q7. Syllabus is completed in time.

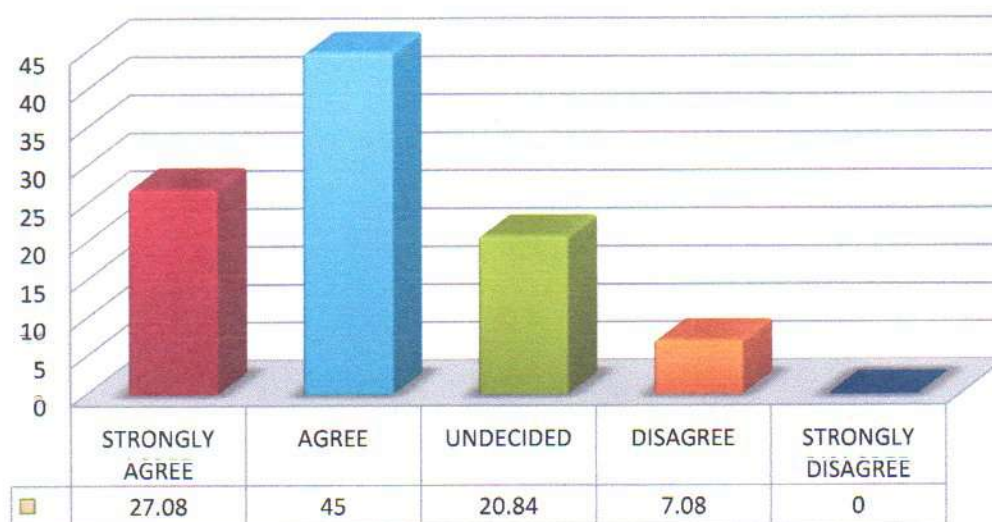




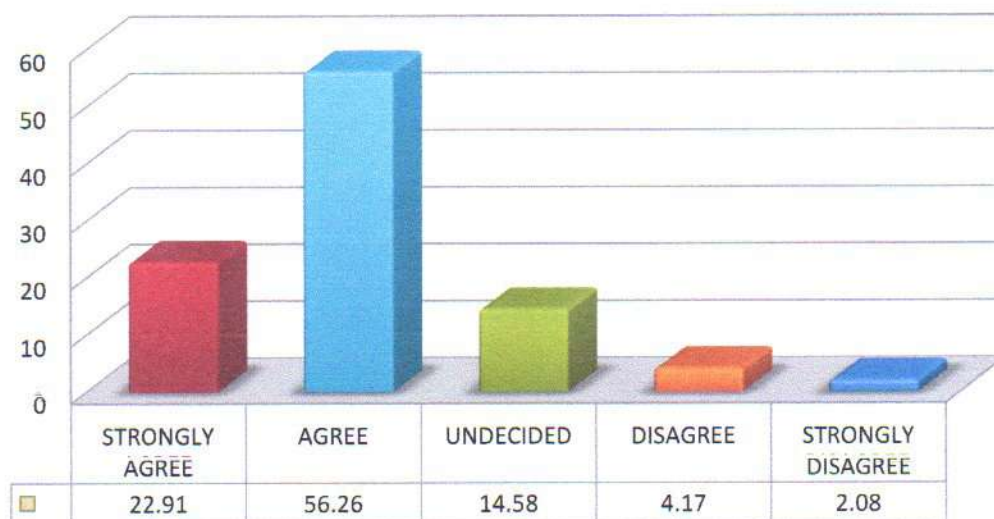
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Q8. All concepts are explained clearly.

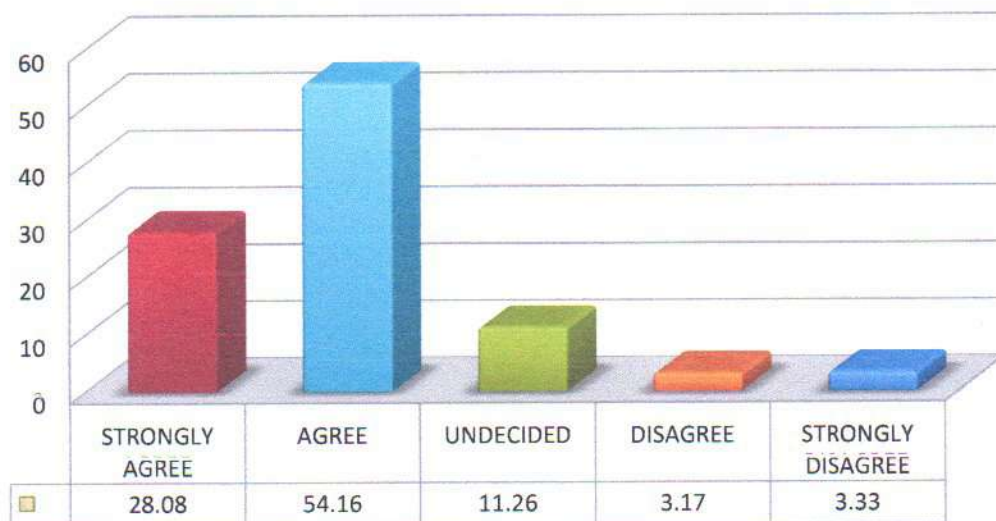


Q9. Teacher contributed maximum level to the college in both scholastic and co-scholastic better.

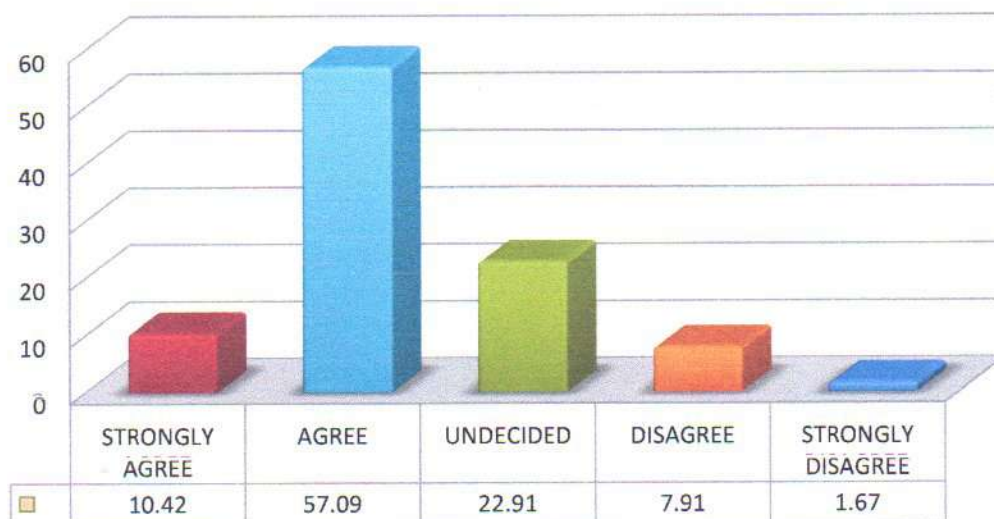



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Q10. Proper teaching aids/ICT had been utilized to make students understand better.

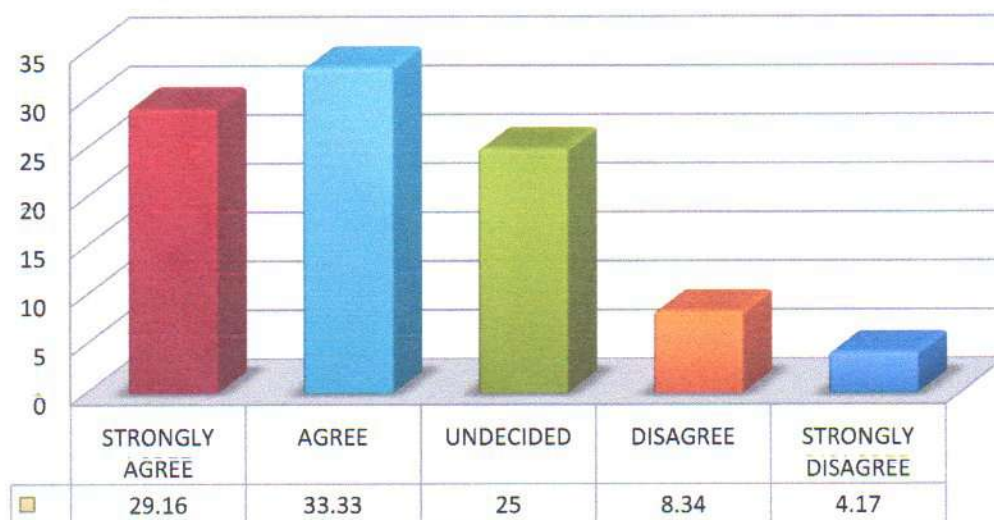


Q11. Instructional objectives set for every class is always fulfilled

The students made various suggestion to improve teaching-learning experience in the college . Some of the suggestions are given below:-

- iii) Availability of latest innovative study materials and books in the library.
- iv) More use of ICT based teaching learning materials in the classrooms.

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## **Analysis Interpretation**

The feedback on Teaching Assessment by the students shows that majority of the student teachers agreed that they are able to construct new knowledge with the teaching learning process in the classroom. 60% of the student teachers agreed that they are able to link the knowledge acquired from their course of study into their real life situations. Majority of the student teachers are satisfied with the orientation and workshop conducted at the institutions as it is helpful for academic as well as personality development. The faculty members contributed maximum level in development of both scholastic and co-scholastic area of development of student teachers. 54.16% of student teachers agreed that the teacher utilized latest and innovative teaching learning materials to male student teacher understand the teaching learning process in a better way.

## **Action Taken**

With respect to the feedback of the students teachers, latest reading materials and books are to be uploaded in accordance to the needs of the curriculum. The teachers are also informed to complete the syllabus, to discuss the problems faced by the students. More orientation and workshop is planned to be taken up on a wider scale in the coming academic year.



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
