

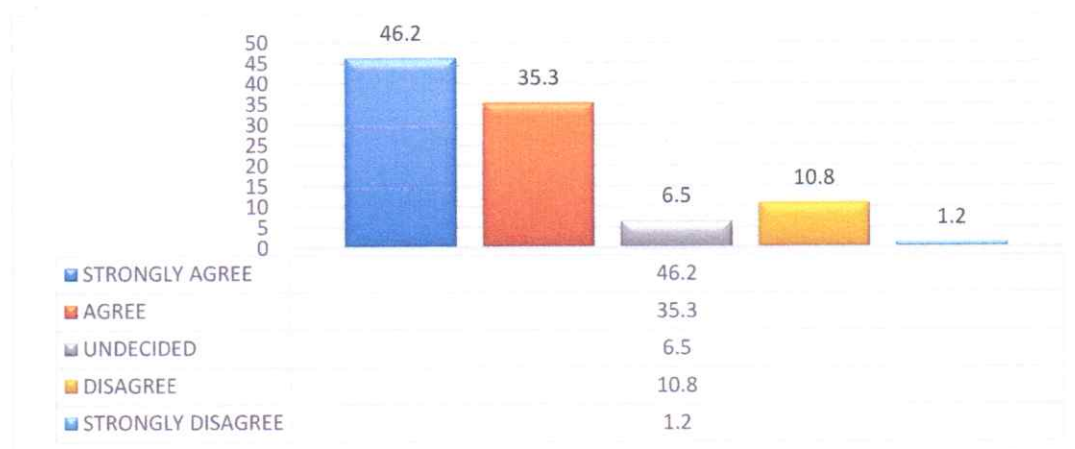

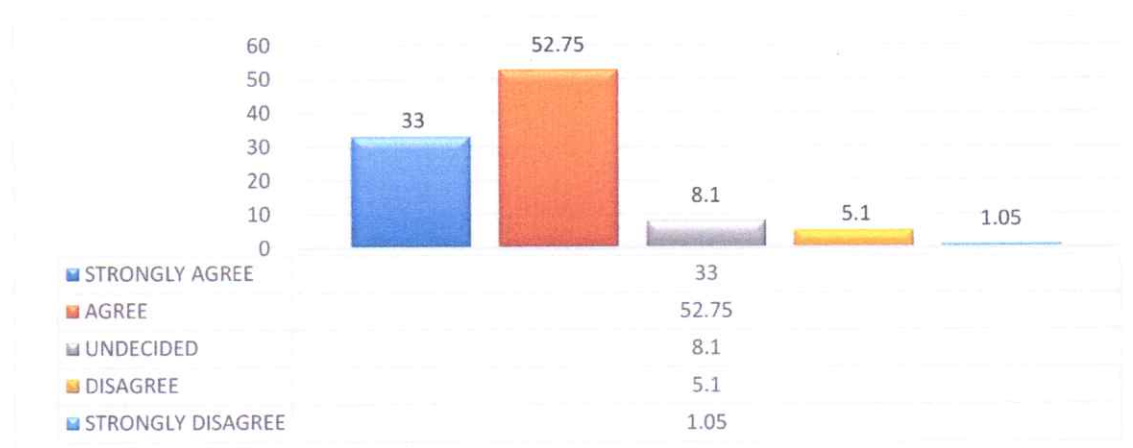
The responses of the students regarding teaching and assessment as presented in percentage format.

Q3. Every lesson/portion taught is always linked to real life situations whenever required.

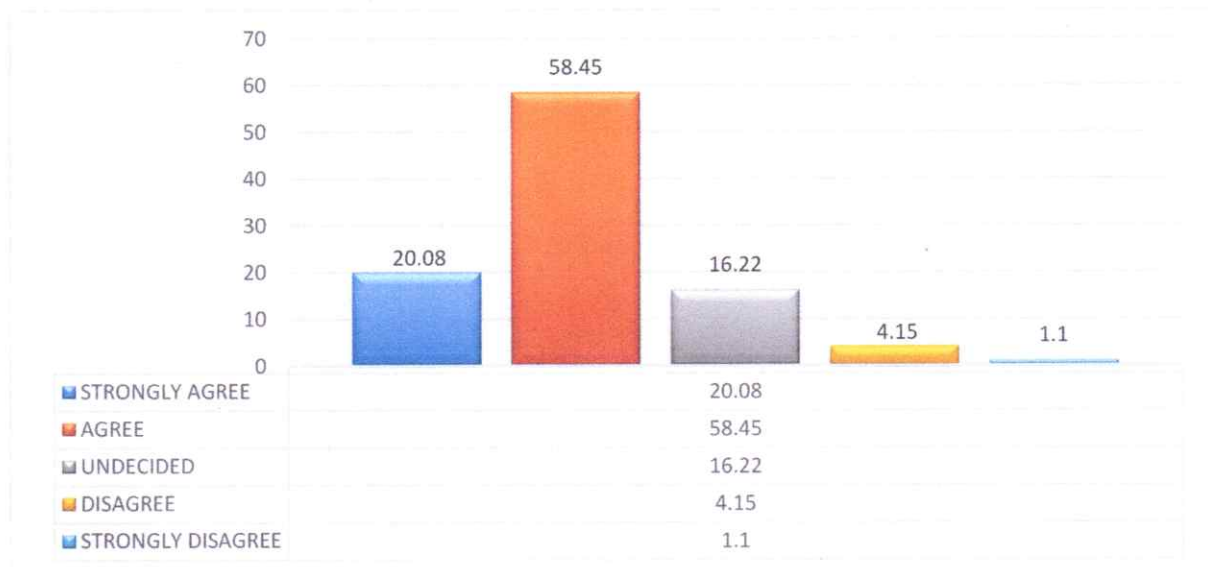

Q4. Orientation and workshop conducted for the teacher at the institution had been helpful.

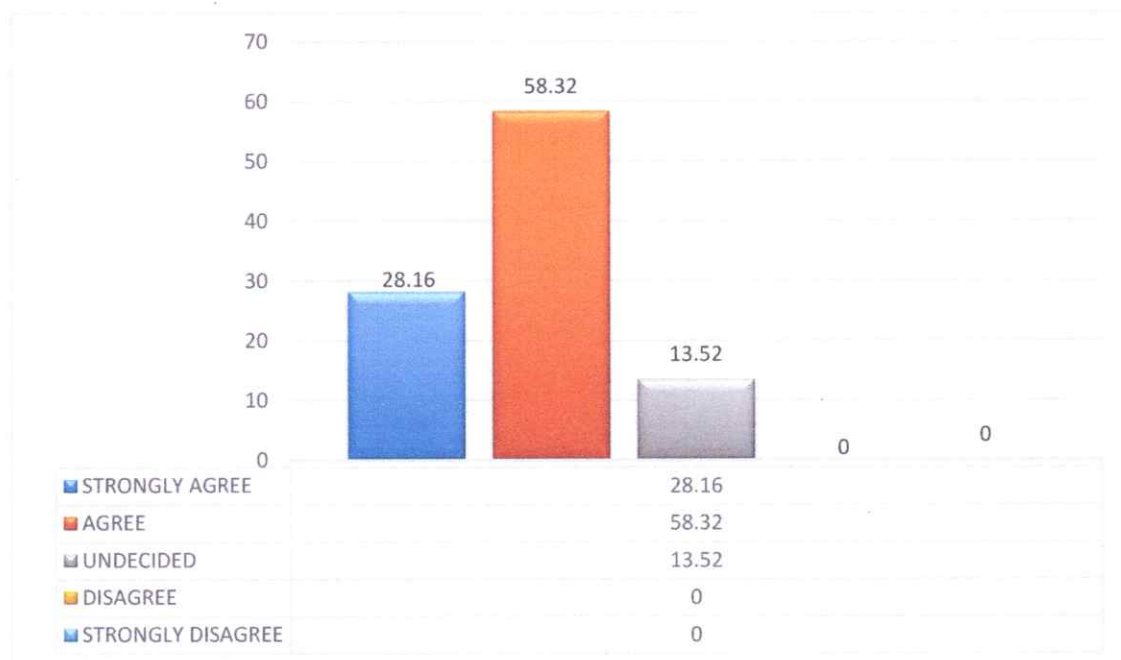

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Q5. There is conducive teaching learning atmosphere in the class

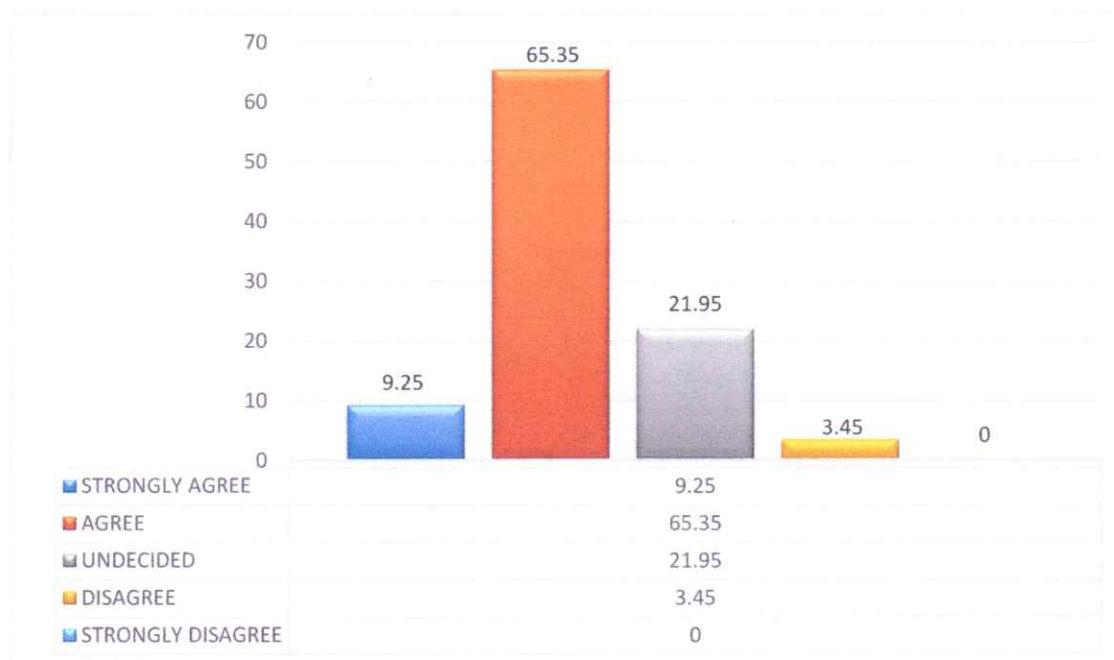

Q6. The teaching has helped the students to garner new knowledge.

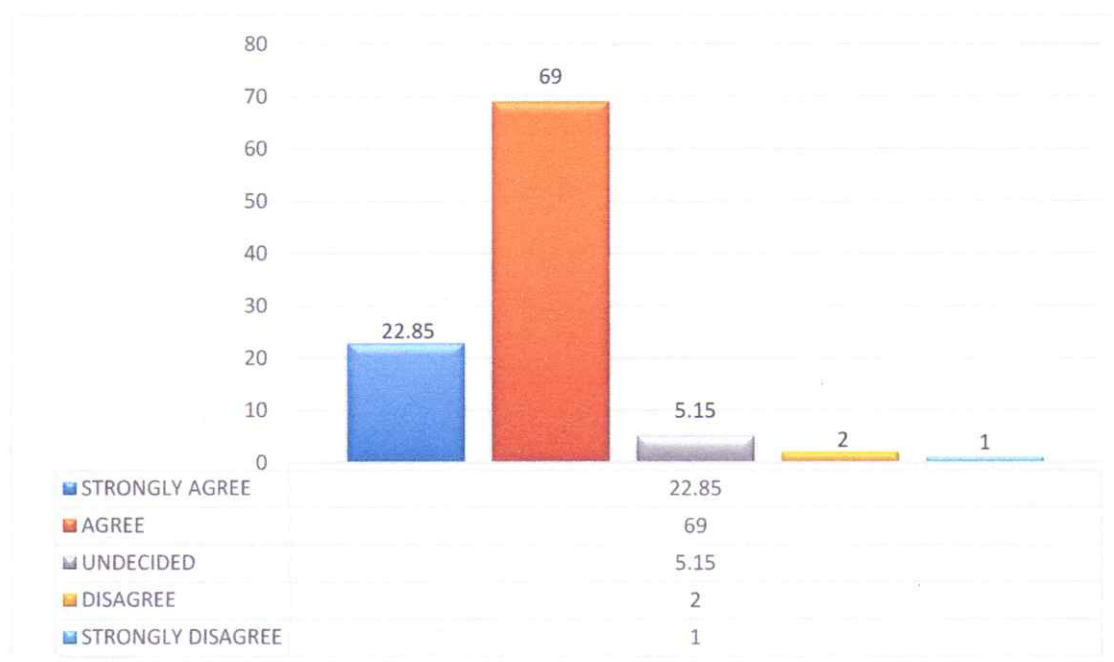

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Q7. Syllabus is completed in time.

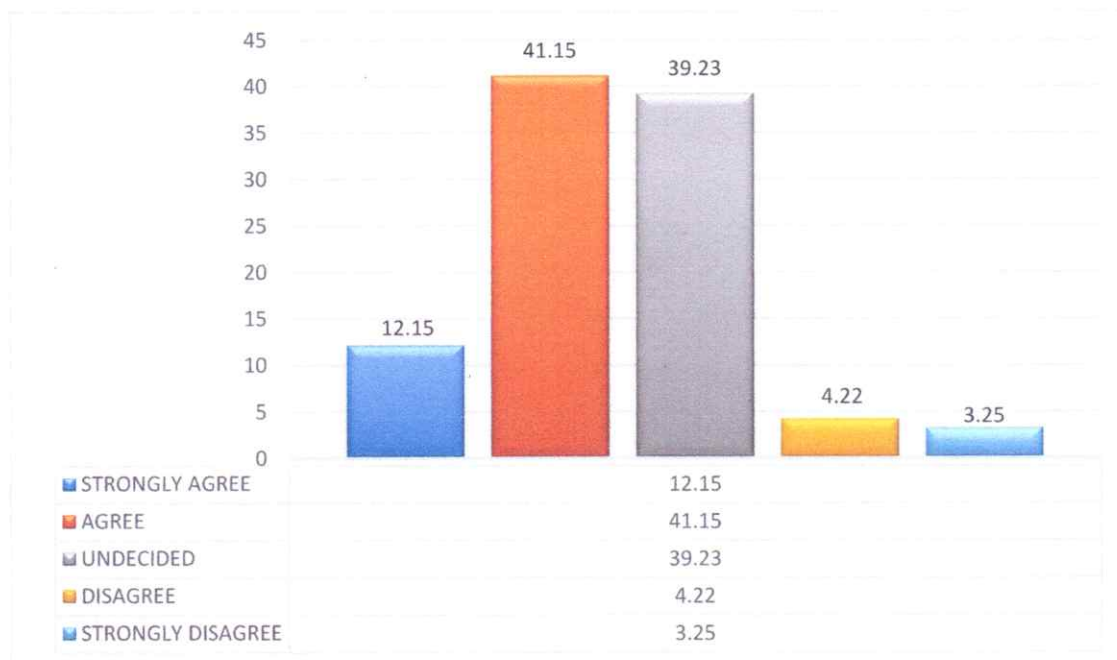

Q8. All concepts are explained clearly.

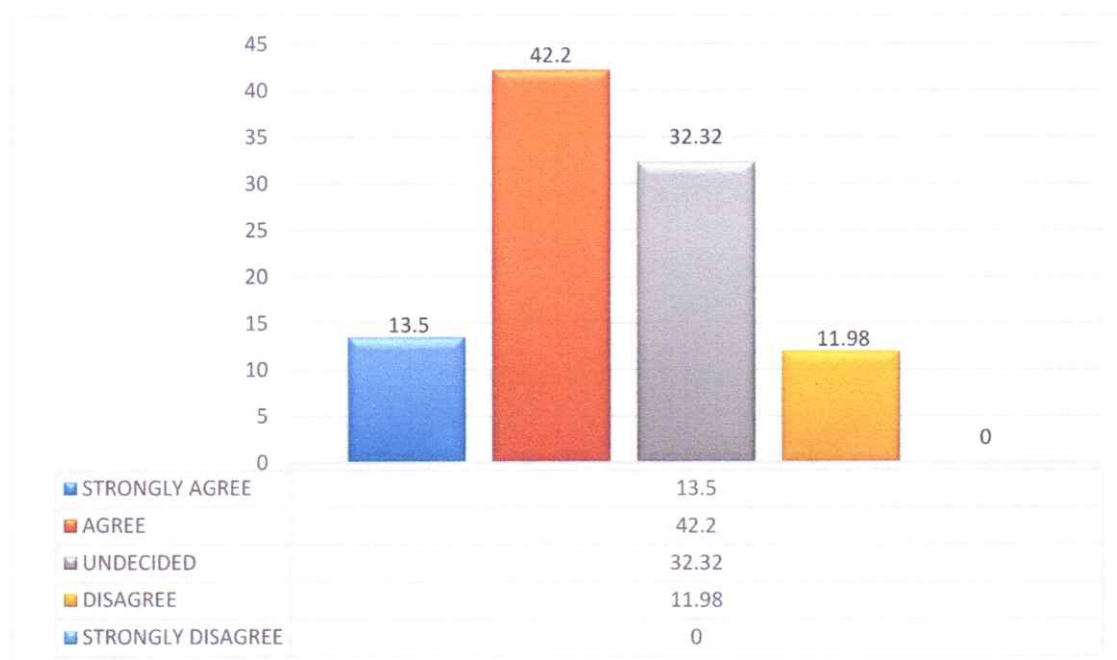

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Q9. Teacher contributed maximum level to the college in both scholastic and co-scholastic area

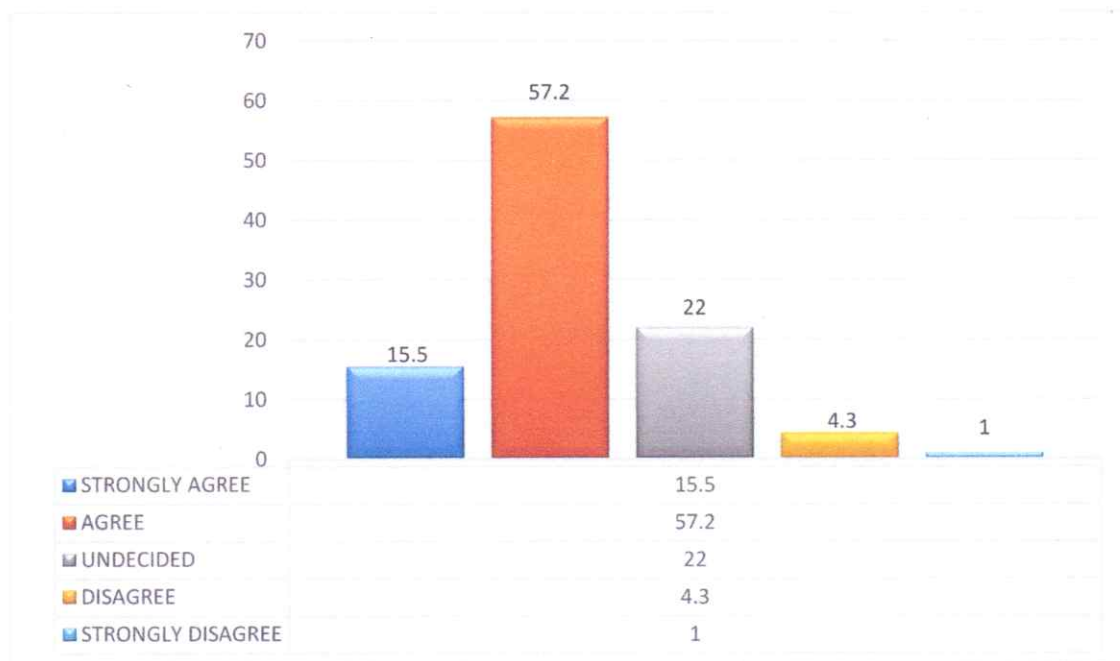

Q10. Proper teaching aids/ICT had been utilized to make students understand better.

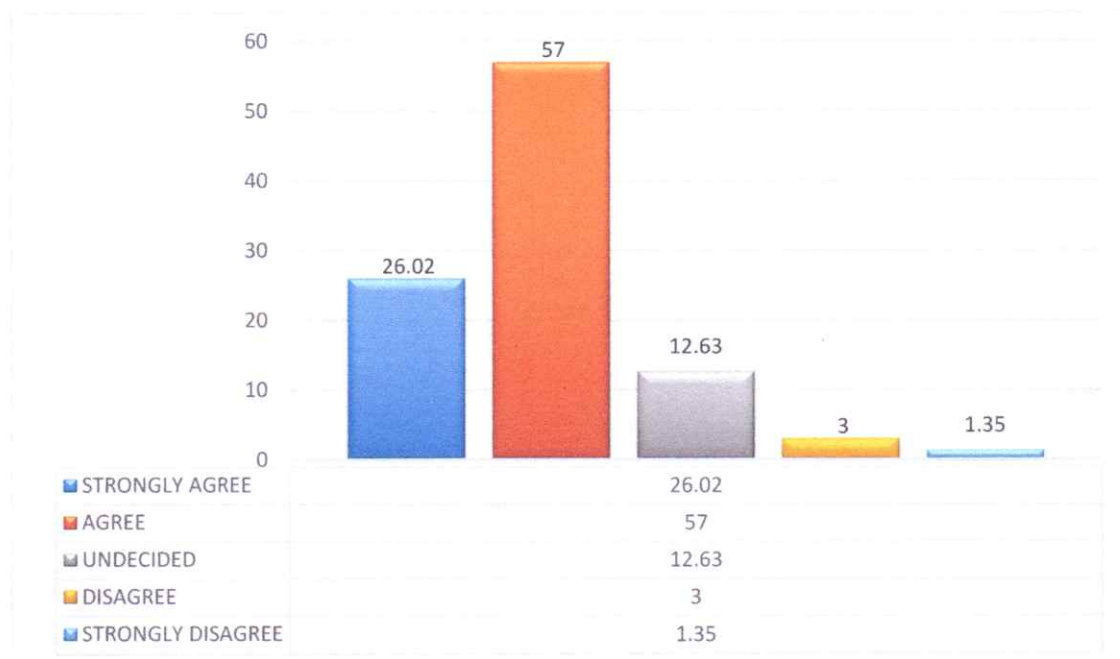

Q11. Instructional objectives set for every class is always fulfilled.

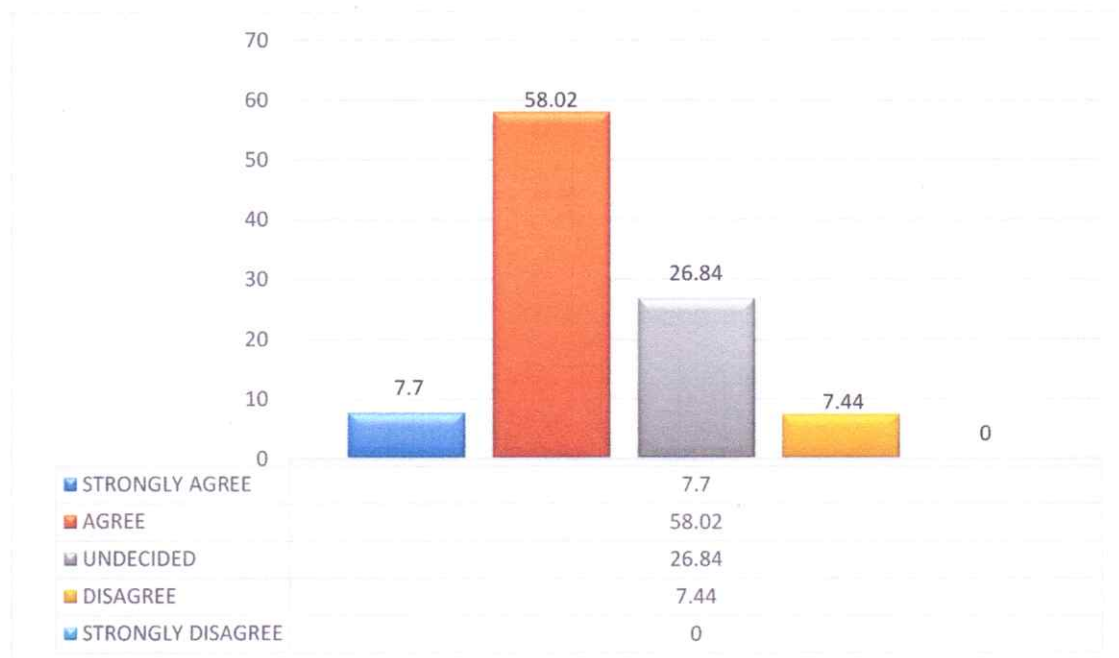

Q12. Teacher needs to have more knowledge to meet the requirements of the curriculum/students.

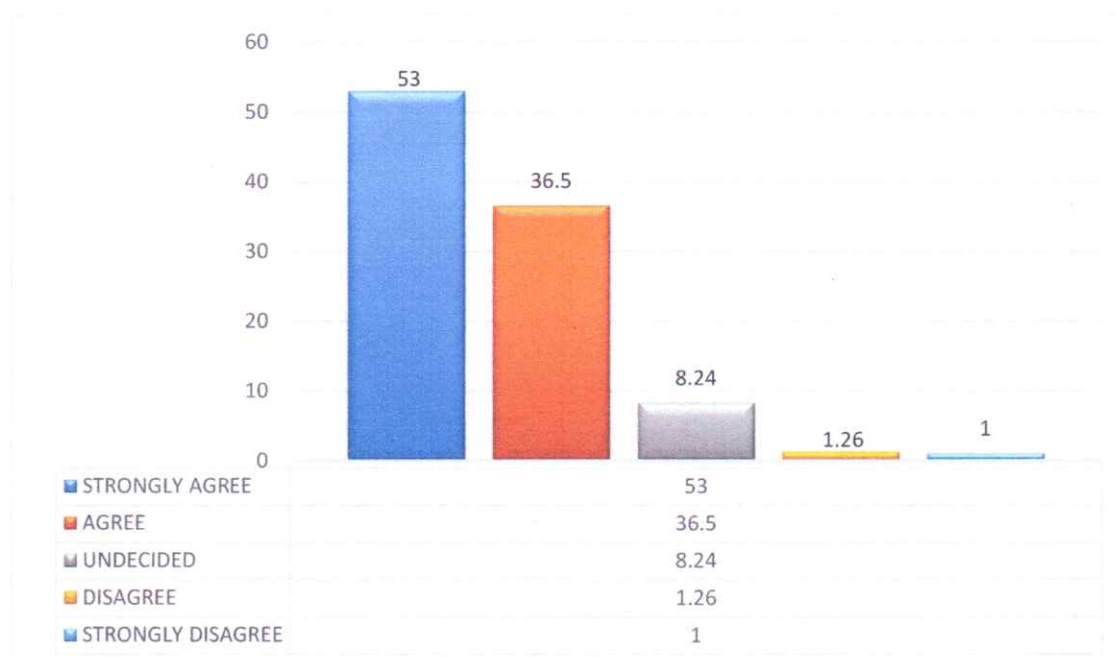

- (vi) Use of Bilingual method in transaction of knowledge.


### Analysis and Interpretation

The feedback on Teaching Assessment by the students show that majority of the students are satisfied with the teaching-learning process. The problem with the completion of the syllabus is the slight problem, as 39.23% of students are undecided about the completion. Q12 on the knowledge required teacher, students agree whole heartedly that there is need for more knowledge by teachers. Responses to Q13 shows that students are not very happy with the library books collection and requires more time to communicate with teachers, regarding not only scholastic areas, but also overall areas of teaching-learning.

### Action Taken

As according to the feedback of the students, teacher orientation, discussion on transaction is planned to be taken up on a wider scale in the coming academic year. Library books and reading materials are to be uploaded in accordance to the needs of the curriculum.
