
Q9. Contributed maximum level to the college in both scholastic and co-scholastic area





Q10. Proper teaching aids/ICT had been utilized to make students understand better.




Q11. Instructional objectives set for every class is always fulfilled.

TEACHER FEEDBACK

Analysis and Interpretation of Teacher Feedback

The feedback of teacher assessment through online platform using structured questionnaire shows that 80.8% teachers prepared lesson appropriately before entering their class. 80.8% of faculties used various processes in their teaching to make students construct new knowledge. Majority of the teachers translated the approach of teaching to real life situations beyond curriculum. The faculty members contributed maximum level in contributing towards scholastic and co-scholastic area of development. And also all concepts are explained clearly. A few teachers feel that they remained undecided whether the syllabus is completed in time.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

In response to the feedback submitted by the faculties, some teachers mentioned that they do not prepared their lesson prior to their class. In this regard, a few teachers suggested that they could not get the ample of time to complete the syllabus and also regarding the completion of objectives of every class is not always fulfilled. In this regard IQAC has taken up necessary steps for the welfare of the teachers as well as the students to meet the above requirements.
