About the College

Dhanamanjuri College of Teacher Education (DMCTE), Imphal (A NAAC Accredited Institution with NCTE, Recognition and Affiliated to Manipur University) got its' birth from the first ever Education Department of the erstwhile D. About the Seminar

From all possible angles we must encourage the genius, highly motivated, fully spirited young men and women to the teaching field.

Teacher education is vital in creating a pool of school teachers that will shape the next generation. Teacher preparation is an activity that requires multidisciplinary perspectives and knowledge, formation of dispositions and values, and development of practice under the best mentors. Teachers must be grounded in Indian values, languages, knowledge, ethos, and traditions including tribal traditions, while also being well-versed in the latest advances in education and pedagogy.

As per NEP 2020, we need to link the good/ best policies and practices of school education with teacher education for both pre-service and in-service education levels with the combination of arts, Science subjects, curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for 4 different levels/stages (foundational, preparatory, middle and secondary) to develop academic and non-academic skills in teacher aspirants.

The NEP 2020 talks about bringing an overhaul in the Teacher education and requirement for improving and reaching the levels of integrity and credibility required to restore the prestige of the teaching profession. The policy document also mentioned about making teacher education programmes educationally sound, multidisciplinary, and integrated programme by 2030

Further, according to NEP 2020, teacher education requires multidisciplinary inputs in the fields of psychology, philosophy, sociology, neuroscience, Indian languages, arts, music, history, literature, physical education, science and mathematics and education in high-quality content as well as pedagogy, all teacher education programmes must be conducted within composite multidisciplinary institutions. The policy document also highlighted about establishing education departments which, besides carrying out cutting-edge research in various aspects of education, will also run integrated teacher preparation programme.
